Before You Begin

⚠ CAUTION: Risk of injury. Always wear safety glasses when cutting or drilling.

- Before starting the installation, lay out and identify the parts. Inspect them for damage.
- The bath/shower or receptor should be installed/prepared at this time, including finished wall materials.

Installation on Tiled Surfaces

If your shower door will be installed over tiles, ensure the tiles are fully laid beneath the door frame.



Shower Door Care

Do not use abrasive pads or sharp tools on any metal parts or glass surfaces.


To maintain a clean and like-new appearance, wipe with diluted mild soap and water.

We recommend using a squeegee to dry the glass panels after each use.














Detailed Diagram of Shower Door Components





NOTE: If the door panels are misaligned or not vertical after installation, adjust the screw above the rollers to correct their position.






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

STEP 11

Sealing

NOTE

The surfaces need to be clean and free of debris before applying silicone.

NOTE

Make sure that the shower door is tightly closed and opens smoothly. Use silicone sealant to seal along the entire length of the Wall Jamb **F** and Bottom Track **L**.



Allow 24 hours for the silicone to cure before using the shower.
